**Associate Membership Agreement**

**Introduction**

Please read the following agreement carefully. By accessing a We The County Membership, you (hereinafter known as “I” or “my”) do hereby apply for associate membership in WE THE COUNTY, PMA beginning this day. I accept the offer to become an associate member of WE THE COUNTY, PMA and agree to pay an annual membership fee of \$25. I give my oath that I am joining of my own free will, am at least the age of majority, am competent to make my own judgments, and handle my own affairs. Furthermore, I have read and agree with the following from the Declaration and Purpose of the Articles of Organization.

**What We Believe**

ORIGINAL INTENT OF THE CONSTITUTION OF THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA

1. God created all things.
2. God gave us our unalienable rights.
3. God is our Supreme Judge.
4. God is our Divine Providence.
5. All laws are based on Biblical principles.
6. Any and all laws that violate God’s laws are unconstitutional and should be null and void.
7. The greatest authority to govern is at the local level.
8. The United States Constitution and the State Constitutions are to limit the government, not the people.
9. All laws are transparent, simplistic, and forthright.
10. Congress shall make NO LAWS prohibiting our God-given rights of religion, speech, the press, right to assemble, or our right to bear arms.

**We The County’s Goals and Objectives**

1. Bring the authority to govern back to the local community, aligning with the Original Intent of the Constitution for a limited Federal Government and local self-governance.
2. Help parents regain control of their children’s education by collaborating with educators.
3. Form strong communities that support the right to express opinions without vilification.
4. Expose corruption in the government, big pharma, social media, and major news networks, holding elected officials accountable.
5. Educate people about the importance of supporting local businesses.
6. Protect Constitutional Rights during health emergencies, including freedom to assemble and freedom of religion.
7. Ensure medical treatments are decided between a doctor and his/her patient, without government interference.
8. Create a supportive community hub for events and local happenings.
9. Provide a platform for individuals to be heard and stand up for Constitutional Rights.

## **Terms and Conditions**

1. This PMA and all members thereof are entitled to carry out all lawful, private interests of We The County, privately.
2. Provide a private platform for members to make claims against any actors breaching the members' common rights or the association's rights.
3. Protect from any tyrannical acts that may infringe upon the rights of members as recognized by laws governing PMAs.
4. Encourage members and associate members to lead and participate in WTC functions with biblical principles as their guide.
5. Participate in other activities that may be deemed necessary and proper by the WTC Leadership to further the goals and objectives of the Association, as long as these actions are not unlawful or infringe on the rights of others.
6. Ensure the right to contract and the freedom of association while acting within the private domain.
7. Recognize members of the Association in accordance with the principles and policies, providing an atmosphere for exercising constitutional rights, health, education, and sharing ideas.
